Purpose	To support scholastic, creative and experiential honors projects. Honors Hours Requirement	By the time of application, you must have 6 honors hours on UA campus.*

* The only exception is for first-semester transfer students, as long as they are enrolled in at least three honors hours in the semester of application (first semester on campus) and complete a total of six honors hours by the end of their second semester on campus
